

Information to be provided in accordance with Art. 13 GDPR where personal data are collected for the innovation award

The protection of your personal data is important to us. We process data that you send to us in connection with an application for the innovation award in order to check suitability for the award and to carry out the application procedure.

3. Purpose and legal basis for processing	We process your personal data for the purpose of carrying out the application procedure. In addition, we process personal data that we have received from other third parties as part of the nomination for the innovation award. This includes submitting the lodged works to the respective jurors for evaluation and, once the award has been determined, processing them as part of the award ceremony for the innovation prize. In addition, as part of the award ceremony, there will be reports on the finalists and winners on our website, as well as in the press and social media channels (e.g. Youtube, Twitter). The processing of the data, in this context is carried out on the legal basis of Art. 6 Para. 1 S.1 lit. b and lit. f GDPR.
4. Recipients of the personal data	Within our foundation, only those departments that are required to fulfil the above-mentioned purposes, will have access to your data.
5. Categories of personal data being processed	Contact data, communication data, personal data (in case of own application: biography of the applicant or the members of the applying project group), the application documents.
6. Period for which the personal data will be stored	The award winners' data will be stored for a maximum period of 12 months. Attendee data will be deleted after the event. In the event that you have agreed to further storage of your personal data, we will delete the data after expiry of the agreed period.
7. Rights of the persons affected	If the legal requirements are met, persons affected have the following rights under Art. 15 - 18 and 35 of the GDPR: Right of access, rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, right to data portability. To exercise your rights, please contact the Data Protection Officer or the data controller. In addition, you have a right of objection to the processing for the protection of legitimate interests, if reasons arise from your particular situation which speak against data processing. We will then no longer process the personal data in the event of a justified objection. You have the right to contact the supervisory authority if you believe that the processing of your personal data is unlawful.
8. Right to withdraw	If you have consented to the processing by means of an appropriate declaration, you can revoke your consent at any time for the future. We will then no longer process your personal data for the purpose for which it was collected.
