The protection of your personal data is important to us. We process data that you have sent to us in connection with your application for funding in order to check your eligibility.

3. Purpose and legal basis for processing	<p>We process your personal data for the purpose of checking your application for funding. The processing of the data required in connection with the decision to guarantee funding is permitted. The legal basis for responding to the request and carrying out the funding is in Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 lit. b GDPR.</p> <p>Should the data, after processing the application for funding, be necessary for legal prosecution, the data may be processed to safeguard legitimate interests pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 lit f GDPR. Our interest is then to defend against claims.</p>
4. Recipients of the personal data	Within our foundation, only those departments that are required to fulfil the above-mentioned purposes, will have access to your data.
5. Categories of personal data being processed	Contact data, communication data, personal data, bank data and data on the project itself.
6. Period for which the personal data will be stored	<p>The data will be stored after collection for as long as this is necessary for the fulfilment of our legal obligations. Funding data is usually deleted 6 years after the last grant expired.</p> <p>In the event that you have agreed to further storage of your personal data, we will delete the data after expiry of the agreed period.</p>
7. Rights of the persons affected	<p>If the legal requirements are met, persons affected have the following rights under Art. 15 - 18 and 35 of the GDPR: Right of access, rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, right to data portability. To exercise your rights, please contact the Data Protection Officer or the data controller.</p> <p>In addition, you have a right of objection to the processing for the protection of legitimate interests, if reasons arise from your particular situation which speak against data processing. We will then no longer process the personal data in the event of a justified objection.</p> <p>You have the right to contact the supervisory authority if you believe that the processing of your personal data is unlawful.</p>
8. Right to withdraw consent	If you have consented to the processing by means of an appropriate declaration, you can revoke your consent at any time for the future. We will then no longer process your personal data for the purpose for which it was collected.
